NeighborWorks® Green Bay Receives Funding to Continue Their Foreclosure Mitigation Counseling Services

(Green Bay) On October 1, 2009, NeighborWorks® America, administrator of the National Foreclosure Mitigation Counseling (NFMC) Program, announced that NeighborWorks® Green Bay was awarded \$33,660 to provide to provide counseling to families and individuals facing the threat of foreclosure. Through the NFMC program, NeighborWorks® Green Bay has counseled 323 households and individuals since July 1, 2008. NeighborWorks® Green Bay began providing foreclosure prevention counseling in 1998.

The NFMC Program granted awards totaling over \$48 million to be disbursed to national agencies for foreclosure mitigation services. In total, more than 1,350 nonprofit counseling agencies across the country are expected to be engaged in the NFMC Program as a result of these awards. It is estimated that more than 128,563 families facing the threat of foreclosure will be directly assisted. To date, more than 698,800 families in all 50 states, Puerto Rico and Guam have received foreclosure counseling through the NFMC Program.

Since January of 2000, NeighborWorks® Green Bay has constructed or renovated 79 dwelling units. In this same period they have educated and counseled 4,513 aspiring home buyers and existing homeowners. NeighborWorks Green Bay has helped 1,346 families achieve their dreams of homeownership through their loan programs. In total, since the year 2000, through their housing development and homeownership programs, they have leveraged modest resources into \$135 million of direct investment in Green Bay's Original Neighborhoods.
